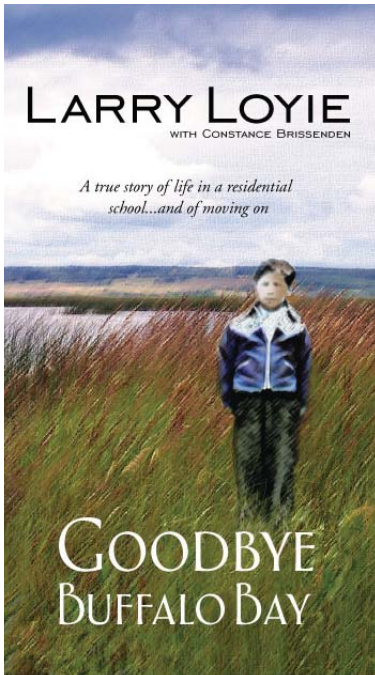

## **Goodbye Buffalo Bay** by Larry Loyie with Constance Brissenden

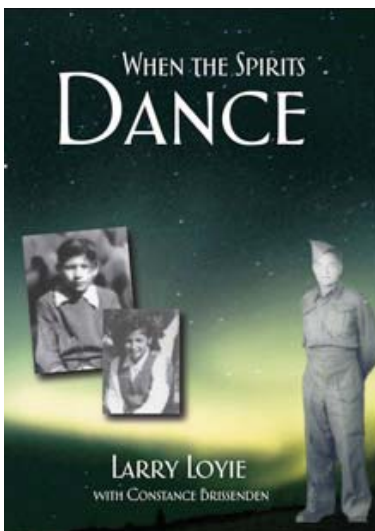
A true story of life in a residential school... and of moving on

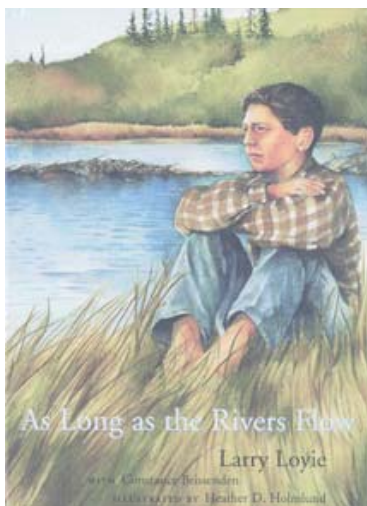

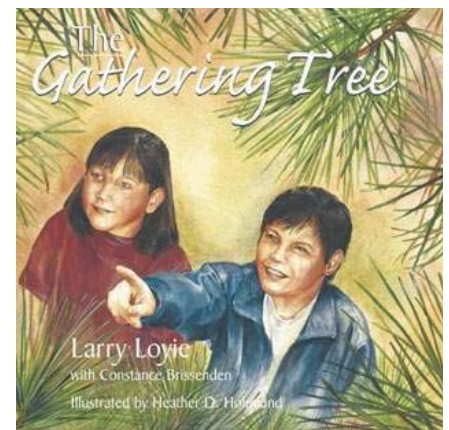
